**HADDOU DUFOURCQ x MAISON POUENAT** Maison Pouenat has been synonymous with French savoir faire and artistry since 1880, and in 2025 it delved into architecturally bold territory by teaming up with designers Kim Haddou and Florent Dufourcq. The metalwork specialist has cast its eye on the future by tapping Haddou Dufourcq's talents for a collection of nickel-plated, aged-aluminium pieces twisted into familiar, contemplative shapes. ## NILUFAR GALLERY

Nina Yashar wields impressive powers of reinvention, proving over and over that the key to ingenuity is constant evolution. Nilufar Gallery's 2025 show, *Repertorio*, was staged in five acts and spread across Nilufar's various locations around Milan. Act 1, *Silver Lining*, was co-curated with Foshury Architecture to mark Nilufar Depot's 10-year anniversary. Anchored by a conversation pit on the ground floor, the floors and makeshift walls were lined with unabashedly pink, furry textures, and accented by metallic objects in a range of silver finishes.
